## Predator Free Bull Creek



### Trapping Program.

Please be aware there are now possum traps set around Bull Creek and in particular in the Bush Track. Traps include foot clamps and Auto resetting traps. The traps are set well away from the walking track, but please be careful with dogs- keep them on a lead.

If you are wanting to do any trapping of possums, rats and stoats around your crib area- here are some suggestions. <https://predatorfreenz.org/get-involved/backyards-and-neighbourhoods/how-identify-backyard-predators/> .

14 possums were caught last evening. What a great start.

### Conservation Grant.

We have identified an opportunity to apply for a Conservation Grant through DOC>This grant will be in excess of \$30,000 (minimum application). It has been proposed that Moanariri Cribowners Assn. could establish a conservation project that would include pest control, removal of [exotic plants](#)/noxious species, fencing bush areas, planting and even a nursery. The Bull Creek Company as Land owner has endorsed this programme should crib owners assn proceed.


